PROPOSAL

Corporate Collaboration



What is it?

Corporate collaboration is a fun, engaging teambuilding simulation which introduces a high level of “ownership mentality” to each of the competing teams. The group is divided up into various companies/ teams and given a limited amount of venture capital with which to start conducting “business”.

A list of projects are then supplied which can generate for the firms varying amounts of profit. Facilitators guide the teams through their Corporate Careers, keeping scores, awarding profits and judging progress.

Delegates are grouped, team leaders are appointed and each receives a written guide with the projects and relative profits attached to the completion of these tasks. Before the project is attempted, each team must define themselves with a Corporate Identity, they are encouraged to form a company culture that mirrors your company’s ethos, mission, vision and values.



How does it work?

We start out with an energising and fun ice breaker. We then split the group into teams. Each team is presented with a pack of face masks to distinguish teams. They will also be provided with a water for the adventure.

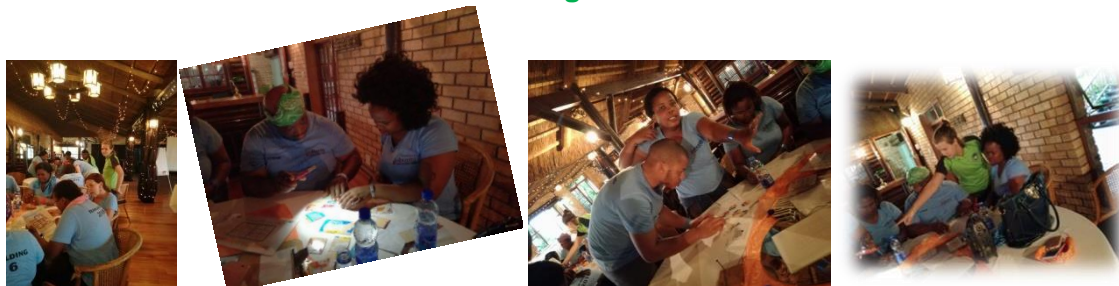
The instructions are given and teams take a few minutes to learn the tools and strategize a plan of action. Then off they go to tackle their first challenge. Once a challenge is completed they will receive a “puzzle piece”. At each challenge a new ‘puzzle piece’ will be awarded.

Teams will interact with each other at various stations, enjoying the same challenge together. The program is structured in such a way as to ensure teams will interact with different teams at all times.

Once all the puzzle pieces have been awarded teams will sit down in a designated area and piece these pieces together. The puzzle pieces, when built correctly, will create a mouse trap powered car.

THESE CARS WILL BE RACED AGAINST EACH OTHER. THE TEAM WITH THE FASTEST CAR, THE FIRST ONE ACROSS THE FINISH LINE, WINS!

The challenge activities:

| 1 | CANDY ELEVATOR (Player must lift 3 sweets to their mouth without using your hands or letting the candy touch the ground.) |
| 2 | A BIT DICEY (Balance six dice on a popsicle stick held in your mouth) |
| 3 | BACK FLIP (Catch increasingly larger sets of pencils, flipped off the back of your hand) |
| 4 | BREAKFAST SCRAMBLE (Player must complete a perfect puzzle using box pieces of a cereal box.) |
| 5 | FACE THE COOKIE (Using only the face, move cookies from the forehead to the mouth.) |
| 6 | HANKY PANKY (Player must pull all of the tissues out of a standard sized box, one at a time, using only one hand.) |
| 7 | NOODLING AROUND (Pick up six penne noodles placed around the perimeter of a table using only a piece of uncooked spaghetti in your mouth.) |
| 8 | READY SPAGHETTI (Using a shared pasta noodle, contestants must pick up soda cans and construct a 3-can pyramid.) |
| 9 | STICK THE LANDING (Player must toss a water bottle onto a table and get it to land upright.) |
